







A globe-trotting British installation artist is about to light up a Silicon Valley landmark.

In late October, the 175-acre grounds of the Montalvo Arts Center, a mansion turned art institution near San Jose, California, will host "Stories in Light," a collection of 10 light installations by Bruce Munro. The artist is best known for his large-scale displays, two of which are currently on view in Australia: at Mount Clarence, Field of Light: Avenue of Honour runs through April 2019, and a version of the same piece at Uluru has extended its run until December 2020. The Montalvo exhibitionwhich is inspired by C. S. Lewis's Chronicles of Narnia and includes a dandelion-shaped cluster of lampposts and a flock of color-changing flamingos—will be the first time so many of Munro's works have been shown in a single location.
