



IAMA THEATRE COMPANY TO STAGE WORKSHOP PRODUCTION OF DOUGLAS LYONS' NEW COMEDY DON'T TOUCH MY HAIR

WHAT: IAMA Theatre Company will continue its 2024/25 season with a workshop production of the final play in the **Douglas Lyons** comedic trilogy, **Don't Touch** My Hair. Lyons created "The Deep Breath Trilogy: New Plays for Black Women" cycle, with **Don't Touch My Hair** that completes the series. The trilogy launched with the family play Chicken & Biscuits on Broadway, called "pure entertainment" by TheaterMania, followed by the romantic comedy Table 17, named a Critics Pick by The New York Times which declared the Off-Broadway play, "something we've been missing: a gentle, hopeful good time out in the world, in the company of other humans. This is theater as comfort food, and it satisfies a genuine craving." A piece about friendship, Don't Touch My Hair follows lifelong best friends Eemani and Jade as they decompress over a good blunt, not knowing the weed is laced with something else. As the duo spiral into a hilarious hallucination, they are able to confront the oppressors of the past deadon. Velani Dibba, who recently served as associate director on the Geffen Playhouse's Waiting For Godot, will direct this new work.
