ABOUT TONY LINDSAY

Tony Lindsay is a Bay Area soul and R&B powerhouse whose 25-year tenure as lead vocalist for Santana earned him 11 Grammy Awards, seven studio album credits, world tours across multiple continents, and a legendary Super Bowl XXXVII pre-game performance alongside Beyoncé. A Kingston, New York native who planted roots in the San Francisco Bay Area in 1980, Lindsay has built a parallel solo career of remarkable momentum, charting multiple No. 1 singles on the Independent Soul charts with his albums "Something Beautiful" (2018) and "Soul Soldier" (2021). His creative fingerprints extend well beyond performance: Lindsay has penned songs for Diana Ross, Tevin Campbell, The Whispers, and Johnny Gill, and lent his voice as background vocalist to recordings by Aretha Franklin, Al Jarreau, Curtis Mayfield, and Steve Winwood, among others. A fixture at Bay Area sporting events singing the National Anthem for the Golden State Warriors, San Francisco Giants, San Francisco 49ers, and San Jose Sharks, Lindsay continues to perform with his longtime band Spangalang while releasing new solo work,

cementing his place as one of the region's most enduring and versatile musical forces.
